Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement

Effective as of April 23, 2009, Registrant amended its April 30, 2007 Credit Agreement with affiliates of Citibank, N.A. and JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., as joint lead arrangers and joint bookrunners, and a group of lenders. The amendment increases the permitted leverage ratio (debt/consolidated EBITDA) to 4.25x through June 30, 2010. The permitted leverage ratio after June 30, 2010 then reduces to and remains at 3.75x until maturity. The amendment includes a re-pricing of the Credit Agreement such that borrowings will bear interest at LIBOR plus a spread (including fees) that will vary between 2.50% and 4.50%, subject to Registrant's credit rating at the time of borrowing. Based on Registrant's current credit rating, the applicable spread would be 3.50%.

Item 2.02. Results of Operations and Financial Condition.

On April 24, 2009, Registrant released its first quarter 2009 earnings and is furnishing to the Securities and Exchange Commission a copy of the earnings press release as Exhibit 99.1 to this Report under Item 2.02 of Form 8-K.

Exhibit 99.1 to this Report contains certain financial measures that are considered non-GAAP financial measures as defined in the SEC rules. Exhibit 99.1 to this Report also contains the reconciliation of these non-GAAP financial measures to their most directly comparable financial measures calculated and presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, as well as the reasons why Registrant's management believes that presentation of the non-GAAP financial measures provides useful information to investors regarding Registrant's results of operations and, to the extent material, a statement disclosing any other additional purposes for which Registrant's management uses the non-GAAP financial measures.
