(Tri-State), the parent company of 1 National Community Bank (FNCB), pursuant to the Agreement and Plan of Merger (the Merger Agreement) among the Company, Tri-State, and FMNB Merger Subsidiary, LLC, a newly-formed wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company (the Merger).
