(6) performance milestone, and as to the remaining 25% on the first anniversary of the first date that both performance milestones were achieved. The performance criteria for the first performance milestone were met on March 18, 2013. The performance criteria for the second performance milestone were met on April 4, 2014, resulting in the vesting of the option as to 14,545 shares, and the remaining 7,273 shares will vest on April 4, 2015.
