The Company believes that such a deadline provides a reasonable time before the Company begins the mailing of its proxy materials for the 2004 Annual Meeting. Stockholder proposals received by the Company after June 18, 2004 will be considered untimely and will not be included in the Company's proxy statement for the 2004 Annual Meeting.
