- (2) upon the distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on an December 10, 2010, stock fund price of \$37.96 per share.  

Each unit of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. The phantom stock units were
- (3) accrued under the Johnson Controls Retirement Restoration Plan. Shares of phantom stock are payable in cash following the reporting person's termination of employment with the company and may be transferred by the reporting person into an alternative investment account at any time.
- (4) Each unit of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. These phantom share units were accrued in the Johnson Controls Long-Term Incentive Plan and are payable in cash following the reporting person's termination of employment with the company. The units may be transferred by the reporting person into an alternative investment account at any time.
- (5) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock.  

The phantom stock units representing dividends which relate to restricted stock awards that were not deferred will vest when the
- (6) non-deferred restricted shares vest, and will be paid in cash to the reporting person. Phantom stock units representing dividends which relate to vested deferred awards are payable in cash following the reporting person's retirement from the issuer and may be transferred into an alternative investment account. Vesting continues when the reporting person retires from the issuer.
- (7) Fifty percent of the options become exercisable two years after the grant date; the remaining 50%, three years after grant date.
