Common Stock, and one-third of the phantom stock is payable in cash or in Cheniere Common Stock if the following average closing stock prices are achieved as reported on the American Stock Exchange for the last 20 trading days of the designated performance period ending Dec. 31, 2008, 2009 or 2010, or any future performance period. The stock prices to be achieved for the performance periods are: 2008 - \$42.00; 2009 - \$50.00; 2010 - \$60.00.
