Item 5.05 Amendments to the Registrant's Code of Ethics, or Waiver of a Provision of the Code of Ethics.

On November 21, 2012, Diebold, Incorporated (the "Company") adopted a new Code of Business Ethics applicable to all directors, officers and employees of the Company. The Code of Business Ethics covers topics such as reporting violations of the Code of Business Ethics, maintaining respectful work environments, fair dealing, confidentiality, compliance with laws, preparation of business and financial documents, conflicts of interests, company resources, public communications and limitations of the Code of Business Ethics, among others.
